Helen was most recently seen as Lady Susan Bloom in a pair of farces at the Drayton Arms: *An Absolute Farce of a Murder Mystery* and *Don't Take The Pith!* both of which

she also directed. Other recent theatre includes Miss Twitterton in Brian Blessed's production of *Busman's Honeymoon* at The Mill at Sonning. She also notably played the title role in Edward Bond's *Dea*, a role created for her by the recently departed playwright.

During her long association with international theatre company TheatreLab she played Herodias in their interpretation of Wilde's Salome – a production which toured internationally over several years; Miss Haversham in Great Expectations; as well as roles in Medea, Jamaica Inn; The Oresteia and Dancing with the Devil at Sadler's Wells. For English Rep Theatre Company she played Gertrude in Hamlet and Madame Arcati in Blithe Spirit, and for Oxford Shakespeare Company – Titania in A Midsummer Night's Dream.

Most recent screen appearances include *The Nevers* for HBO and *Belgravia* for ITV; various commercials, including Volkswagen, Pensionwise, and FibreOne. As co-founder of

Canonbie Productions she co-created web series *The Self-Tapers*, 2018- and *Gentrification*; comedy-crime podcast *Margate Murder Mystery*; and she recently

directed their debut feature film, Quixotic.

LAMBCO is an independent live entertainment production company based in London.

LAMBCO has produced *Do You Have A* Secret Crush?) (Lost Theatre); five Christmas skating events (Torquay); *Bluebirds* (Above The Stag); *Sincerely Yours* and associate producer for *Bewitchment on Black Ice* (Landor), *Boys in the Buff* and *Skin Deep*, both received 5 Star Reviews. *Skin Deep* then went on a National Tour and the Edinburgh Fringe Festival gaining another 5 Star Review and a Fringe Award from Scots Gay, *The Crumple Zone* and *Margot, Dame, the Most Famous Ballerina in the World* (King's Head Theatre).

At the Drayton Arms Theatre and Ed Fest, LAMBCO produced *Boys in the Buff, Tickle, Soho Boy, Bette Midler and Me, Twinkle* and *Love is Blue.* Playbill chose *Boys In The Buff* as their "pick of the fringe" and the Scotsman declared *Tickle* and *Boys In The Buff*, two of the Fringe's four sexiest musicals.

Emerging from the pandemic, LAMBCO created the Garden Theatre in Vauxhall opening a musical ahead of Broadway and the West End – Fanny and Stella, Pippin, Next Thing You Know, Naked Boys Singing and Frostbite.

This year, LAMBCO set up the award-winning Stage Door Theatre, the first pub theatre in the West End, and produced *Marry Me a Little, The Tailor-Made Man, Slices of Life* and this UK premiere of the Broadway musical *The Story Of My Life.*
